# Rules and Regulations



## What should campers bring to camp?

- At least 2 water bottles
  - Suggestion: one cold, one frozen
- Sunscreen
- A healthy lunch and snacks
- Comfortable closed shoes
  - Sandals and flip flops are only accepted at the pool.
- Bathing suit and towel
- A change of clothes
- A cap

  - They have tested positive for covid



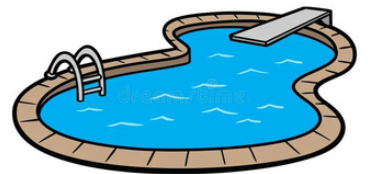

## **Drop off and pick up:**

- If your child is not in daycare, they should be dropped off between 8:50 - 9:00am and picked up at 4 pm at the school entrance.
- If your child is in daycare, they should be escorted into the building between 7-9 am and will need to be signed out between 4-6pm.
- Anything else ?

## **Early Dismissals:**

- If you would like to dismiss your child/children early due to a doctor's appointment, dentist, personal reasons, etc., we ask that you write a note or call their coordinator **THE MORNING OF OR THE DAY BEFORE.**
- Due to camp protocols, we cannot dismiss campers before 4pm if no call was made or note was given.
- **ALL** early dismissal will take place at Leonardo Da Vinci Academy with the coordinator present.
- Your child must be signed out before they can leave.



## **Pool Procedure:**

- Campers must bring their bathing suit, and a towel **EVERYDAY.**
- Swimming goggles are optional.
- We will be attending the Don Bosco Pool on Rita Lévi-Montalcini or Jean Grou Pool.
- Campers will stay in the shallow ends of the Jean-Grou Pool or kiddie pool at Don Bosco Pool.
- Floaties are acceptable to bring.
