



I am more than happy to answer any questions that you might have so do not be afraid to reach out by text or call.




## Special Needs Coordinator

# Rules and Regulations

## What should campers bring to camp?

- *At least 2 water bottles*
  - *Suggestion: one cold, one frozen*
- *Sunscreen*
- *A healthy lunch and snacks*
- *Comfortable closed shoes*
  - *Sandals and flip flops are only accepted during water activities.*
- *Bathing suit and towel*
- *A change of clothes*
- *A cap*

## Early Dismissals:

- *If you would like to dismiss your child/children early due to a doctor's appointment, dentist, personal reasons, etc., we ask that you write a note or call their coordinator THE MORNING OF OR THE DAY BEFORE.*
- *Due to camp protocols, we cannot dismiss campers before 4pm if no call was made or note was given.*
- *ALL early dismissals will take place at East Hill Elementary School with the coordinator present.*
- *Your child must be signed out before they can leave.*



## Centre Rules:



- No food containing nuts
- Respect towards other campers, animators and coordinators
- Foul language will not be accepted
- We are a NO BULLY ZONE
- Think your child may be sick with an infection or virus? (Fever, gastro, respiratory infections, head lice, etc.)
- Should your child have:
  - just a runny nose, they may come to camp.
  - a cough with fever, they are to remain at home.
  - a fever, they are to remain at home for at least 24 hours without fever.
  - Diarrhea or vomiting, they are to remain at home for at least 24 hours after their last episode.
  - should your child have head lice, they are to remain at home and you are responsible for telling your center coordinator
- Your child can return to camp when they are fever and symptom free for at least 24 hours without taking tylenol or advil.
  - please inform us if your child is COVID positive.
- When a child is lethargic and unable to follow the day's activities, we will contact you to come and pick up your child.



## Drop off and pick up:

- If your child is not in daycare, they should be dropped off between 8:50 - 9:00am and picked up at 4 pm at the school entrance. There will be a staff member outside to greet them.
- If your child is in daycare, please enter the building with them between 7-9 am. Those in daycare, between 4-6 pm will need to be signed out.
- To facilitate the dismissal process, each group will be dismissed one at a time.
- For pick up and daycare, please have your ID and passwords ready.

*Campers will be immersed in the world of magic by transforming into young wizards to explore the fascinating world of science.*




## Week 2 - Wizard Quest

(Note: please bring a bathing suit, towel, flip-flops, and a bag to place their wet bathing suit)*


## Week 5 - Fantasy Day
